3. It treats troubles in the sides of the body, viz hypochondriac pain, pain in lateral aspect of leg, pain in lateral side of neck.	125
4. It treats sacrum sciatica (Gall bladder type)	125
5. If one leg is longer than the other, the longer leg is diseased and needs a treatment on the Yang regulating vessel.	126
6. It treats infection, tinnitus and deafness of the ear due to liver fire rising or gall bladder disharmony.	126
7. It also treats low blood pressure, migraine or any disease in one side of the body.	126
8. It treats muscular problems like tightness of the muscles of the lateral leg, baker's leg, hypertonia of calf muscles.	126
9. It treats pain in finger and toes, eagle toes, one leg longer than the other.	127
