PROGRAM STRUCTURE OF "CAMPUS COURSE":

1. The Acupressure Shodh, Prashikshan Evam Upchar Sansthan is conducting Campus Courses in Acupressure Healing Sciences, which are as follows:

2. Sessions:

There will be two semesters every year and session will start twice a year : **January and July**. Accordingly, examinations will be held twice every year, i.e. in the month of June and December.

3. Lateral Entry:

Fresh Students can take admission only in Certificate programme and they can take admission after clearing it, in further programmes. However, they will get benefit of semester cleared previously either from this Academy or from any other recognized University / Institution.

For example: If someone has cleared Certificate programme of one semester and wants to take admission in Diploma Programme, he will get benefit of one semester and he has to clear only second semester of Diploma Programme and accordingly in other Programmes too.
