
2. Research (Cases) – Compilation of case history of patients at Allahabad and outstation centers is being done regularly. Also they are being published in books and magazine –saraswati from time to time. Affiliated centers are regularly sending 3 cases yearly; Still, we had a great back log of earlier recorded case registers, all of which have now been cleared (by the help of Beena Jaiswal and team). Now, a collection of 600+ Ayurvedic, 500+ Chinese, 200+ miscellaneous cases are to be compiled in various books and magazine for our records (which is going on). In this regard, a series of CASE HISTORY MANUALS Vol-1.... Has been decided to be compiled and published from this year; out of this 6 manuals are under process. This shall help the therapists to study through the cases and understand the diagnostic and treatment methodologies of various therapists.

Further, the case history compilation has also at parallel started on the online platform of acuhealthline (www.acuhealthline.in a software on acupressure, developed by Mr. Mahantesh Saboji, Belgaum with an MOU with ASPEUS). Few ASPEUS therapists are trying to feed the day to day cases in the system and teach/ train colleagues so that our records can be really preserved; thereupon online case sorting, disease wise classification and statistical data could be generated. We are always in need of more qualified hands!



3. Research (New Development/ Plottings): In series of new plotings like AVM, AWM, ATM etc., here is one more plotting on Pitta joints of fingers, making this joint as a unit of 3 group meridians. This has been named as "3 group joint meridian" (3GJM). The plotting figure is shown below. The pitta joint in our hands is more elaborate and has many palm lines inbuilt. Mostly therapists put points on this joint in various ways, having location issues. Slowly in the long run, this joint can be used (in routine) as 3 GJM, once therapists are familiar with its ploting. This will help us cover a wider area of this joint, bit above it and a bit below it. There upon, the 10 points of pitta joint are divided into the 3 rings drawn on this joint.




4. Research (Common Recipes):


(a) Navel setting by points — many patients are getting relief by just setting their navel in position using the points — a cluster at navel ayurvedic corr, and Rt thumb V jt 2, 5 sed 1,7 tone. As jerks on roads, etc causing lots of distress, this has worked as a great remedy in the past few months.




(b) Ring Massage on 10 fingers – a simple, rigorous massage by ring, 1 min each finger, once a day has also brought great relief to patients. Specially in fatigue and bodyaches etc. Those whose finger joints are painful, are advised to use mega rings of wrist joint to massage on wrist joints 1/day.




(c) **Severe heat/Loo** – these days the seasonal treatment of NCH (6) 3sed 9 tone by byol magnet or NCH (6) green colour is a great relief and provides cooling effect to patients.



(d) A diagnostic tool – check all the major organs corr points on the palm. Find out the most painful point/ organ corr. Apply cluster star magnet and do an overall healing. Also one can check inference on this point and apply a chakra magnet on palm or a super byol on insect corr and easily keep ONE MAGNET for overhauling/ servicing of the human body. If further discomfort, select that organ related joint; for example if liver corr is most painful, use F 3 K jt and so on.





(e) CM in AM – Chinese meridians in Ayurvedic Mould, a new book and concept being developed; using TCM meridian points on the finger joints 10 points as per ayurvedic acupressure. There had been regular queries by therapists across the country as to how to use TCM protocols in ayurvedic system. Now by this, they can generate their own ayurvedic points using the CM in AM chart-books coming soon.

5. Research (Explanation on group meridian) – The concept of group meridians was developed to group together the multiple meridians of ayurvedic acupressure and to approach a problem through minimum points and maximum meridian coverage. In this regard, the concepts of Vm, HZM, SPM the 3 main meridians were clubbed together, first into 2 as LVM, LHM, RLHM, LSPM etc. Then after there was a need to club 3 and more meridians as the patients of varied grave diseases, approached to us. Hence a pattern of grouping/ clubbing meridians together was developed in the form of a chart (Mag 2016-2).

This chart was developed keeping in mind, only 10 points in all group combinations. i.e. if we join 2 or any number of more meridians together, all will work as one meridian and total points will be 10 in all. For example, group of 2 meridians, each meridian has 5 points; group of 3 meridians, each has 3 points and last one has 4 points as covers maximum energy as of 9 number. So equal distribution of points in all group meridians has been kept for easy understanding. We shall take a few examples below to understand the varied aspects of group meridians and their usage:

Ex. 1 : Group of 2 VM or 2 HZM or 2 SPM; if 3-4 VM/ HZM/SPM is grouped , the points will be – 3VM/HZM/SPM will have 01**234** points and

4 VM/HZM/SPM will have 56789 points.

To apply, 245sedate 37tone on 3-4 VM/HZM/SPM, select the meridian and the points as stated above i.e.

24 sedate, 3 tone on 3VM/HZM/SPM and

5 sedate, 7 tone on 4 VM/HZM/ SPM.

Ex. 2: Group of 3 VM/ HZM/SPM; if 2-5-7 VM/HZM/SPM are grouped, the points will be 2VM/HZM/SPM will have 012 points,

5VM/HZM/SPM will have 345 points,

7VM/HZM/SPM will have 6789 points; as shown in the group chart.

To apply, <u>protocol 2-5-7 VM/HZM/SPM group - 245sedate 37tone</u>, select the meridian and the points as stated above i.e.

2VM/HZM/SPM will have 012 points,......2 sedate

5VM/HZM/SPM will have 345 points,..........3 tone, 45 sedate

7VM/HZM/SPM will have 6789 points......7 tone

Ex. 3 : Group of 10VM/HZM/SPM; if all 0-9 VM/HZM/SPM are grouped, the points and the protocol (2457sedate, 368 tone) will be :

Protocol = All VM/HZM/SPM group- 2457 sedate, 368 tone :

0 VM/HZM/SPM will have 0 point,

1 VM/HZM/SPM will have 1 point,

2 VM/HZM/SPM will have 2 point,....2 sedate

3 VM/HZM/SPM will have 3 point,....3 tone

4 VM/HZM/SPM will have 4 point,...4 sedate

5 VM/HZM/SPM will have 5 point,...5 sedate

6 VM/HZM/SPM will have 6 point,...6 tone

7 VM/HZM/SPM will have 7 point,...7 sedate

8 VM/HZM/SPM will have 8 point,...8 tone

9 VM/HZM/SPM will have 9 point; as shown in group chart.

These examples were of simple grouping of more than one meridian, with same set of points i.e. in 2 or more meridians, in each meridian, same treatment is given. There are other means also where we can club/group the meridians to reduce number of points.

Ex. 4 : Group of fingers, with same meridian : Protocol F 3, 4, 5- 3 spm- 23 sedate 14 tone; in this 3 fingers can be grouped as in all 3 fingers, same 3rd spm is taken.

F 4 V jt= points 67.....6 tone

F 5 V jt= points 89

In this manner, grouping of any number of meridians with similar patterns of treatment, can be grouped together. Now this facility is also available in the online software www.acuhealthline.in, where a therapist/staff can log in and feed the case of the patient and generate the group chart of that patient. For any further query and help for group patterns, kindly attend national conference for updations.

Many recipes of group meridian cases are being published from magazine 2017 onwards in the case history section of local and outside therapists panels. Kindly go through the cases and you may directly consult the concerned therapist also. How and when to use these group meridians is purely dependent on the gravity of the patient's disease and how many meridians/platforms of treatment, the therapist needs to select. For example, if whole

spine is affected, we can take all VM of F6 as a group as F 6 V Jt covers spine and its branch all VM belong to V jt. Similarly all spm- group for eyes can be taken on F 3; all hzm group for lungs on F1 and all hzm group for Kid on F 4, For heart on F 2 – all hzm group, for stomach on F 5 all VM group and for blood disorders F3 all spm group etc. This concept of covering group of all VM/HZM/SPM on a finger is similar to overhauling/servicing of that element, its organs, tissues. (an advanced treatment, similar to ring massage). This can be worked on by inference of energy on group meridian points and thereby applied.

Here is a small effort to bring a write up on group meridians. Slowly we shall take up one by one the new developments of the therapy in this section and updating all our therapists with the latest developments in this fiel(d) Also this section invites works done by our therapists, exclusively in this field and if they would like to share their mysterious points/protocols/concepts, they can email to aspeus.mag@rediffmail.com with subject – research section.
